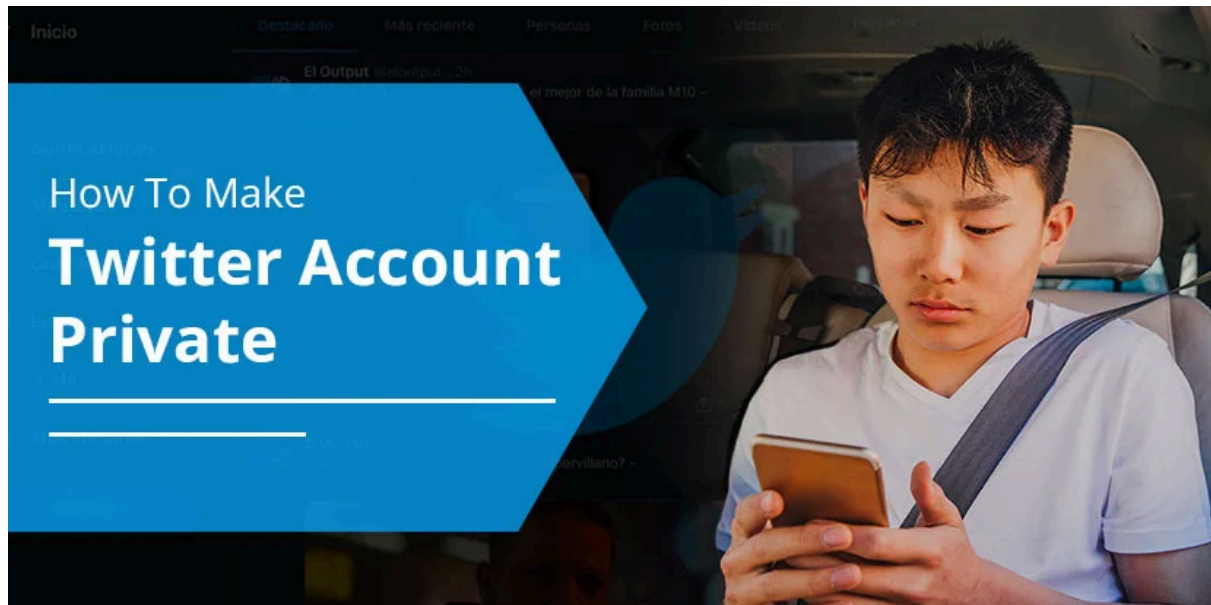


Can You See Who Views Your Facebook Profile - Below's Described
